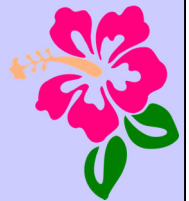
ST. BLAISE PRESENTATION

BOY SCOUT SUNDAY INVITATION

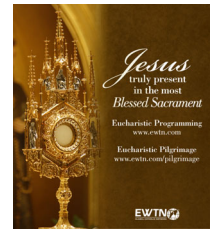
