

LENT: FAST & ABSTINENCE

The following guidelines are provided by the Diocese: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of **Fast and Abstinence** and all the Fridays of Lent are days of Abstinence. Abstinence is from meat by Catholics 14 years and older. Fasting is by all Catholics 18 years of age but not yet 59. Those bound by this rule may take one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted as necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid food between meals is not permitted.

St. Regis Lent begins with a mission. It is that time of the year in which we are invited to share what we have received in terms of faith. There are going to be baskets with crosses and info-cards about ways to be a part of St. Regis. Please take them to the people around you and invite them to participate in our community celebrating our faith in Jesus. Become a missionary of the love of our Lord and go and make disciples.

Also, please join us for Lenten talks with our deacons on Wednesdays after the 6:00 pm Adoration on Feb 28, March 6, 13 & 20.

Pray with us the Stations of the Cross at 4:30 in the church on all Fridays of Lent and join us after the Stations for the Shrimp Boil in the Parish Hall.

Join us for the celebration of Masses on Ash Wednesday February 14, at 8:30 am, 6:00 pm and 7:30 pm (Spanish).

Finally remember that Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence (no meat). For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

CUARESMA: AYUNO Y ABSTINENCIA

La Diócesis proporciona las siguientes pautas: El Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo son días de ayuno y abstinencia y todos los viernes de Cuaresma son días de **abstinencia**. La abstinencia es de carne por parte de los católicos mayores de 14 años. El ayuno es para todos los católicos de 18 años de edad, pero aún no de 59. Los sujetos a esta regla pueden tomar una comida completa. Se permiten dos comidas más pequeñas según sea necesario para mantener la fuerza de acuerdo con las necesidades de cada uno, pero no se permite comer alimentos sólidos entre comidas.

Además, los viernes durante la Cuaresma son días obligatorios de abstinencia (sin carne). Para los miembros de la Iglesia católica latina, las normas sobre el ayuno son obligatorias desde los 18 años hasta los 59 años. Cuando se ayuna, a una persona se le permite comer una comida completa, así como dos comidas más pequeñas que juntas no equivalen a una comida completa. Las normas relativas a la abstinencia de carne son obligatorias para los miembros de la Iglesia católica latina a partir de los 14 años.
