THOUGHTS FROM FR. EMMANUEL

Friends,

This weekend we celebrate the great Solemnity of Corpus Christi. This Feast originated around 1261, when Jacques Pantaléon, formerly archdeacon of Liège, became pope as Urban IV. In 1264 he ordered the whole church to observe the feast. Urban's order was confirmed by Pope Clement V at the Council of Vienne in 1311-12. By the mid-14th century, the festival was generally accepted, and in the 15th century it became, in effect, one of the principal feasts of the church.

Eucharistic Adoration:

The importance of Eucharistic Adoration is shown in the fact that the Church has a ritual that regulates it: the Rite of Eucharistic Exposition and Benediction. This is an extension of the adoration of the Blessed Sacrament which occurs in every Mass: "Behold the Lamb of God, behold him who takes away the sins of the world. Blessed are those called to the supper of the Lamb." Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament flows from the sacrifice of the Mass and serves to deepen our hunger for Communion with Christ and the rest of the Church. The Rite concludes with the ordained minister blessing the faithful with the Blessed Sacrament.

Holy hours are the Roman Catholic devotional tradition of spending an hour in Eucharistic Adoration in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament. The bishops have created a variety of holy hours that focus our prayer to Jesus Christ on peace, life, vocations, and other topics that are at the heart of the life of the Church and the world. Recent popes have urged Catholics to take up the ancient practice of prayer before the Blessed Sacrament.

Please choose an hour to be with the Lord in adoration in our small chapel and help us to reach out the goal of **Perpetual Adoration** in St Regis.

PENSAMIENTOS DEL P. EMMANUEL

Amigos

Este fin de semana celebramos la gran solemnidad del Corpus Christi. Esta fiesta se originó alrededor de 1261, cuando Jacques Pantaléon, ex archidiácono de Lieja, se convirtió en papa como Urbano IV. En 1264 ordenó a toda la iglesia que observara la fiesta. La orden de Urbano fue confirmada por el papa Clemente V en el Concilio de Vienne en 1311-12. A mediados del siglo XIV, la fiesta era generalmente aceptada, y en el siglo XV se convirtió, de hecho, en una de las principales fiestas de la iglesia.

Adoración Eucarística:

La importancia de la Adoración Eucarística se muestra en el hecho de que la Iglesia tiene un ritual que la regula: el Rito de Exposición y Bendición Eucarística. Esta es una extensión de la adoración del Santísimo Sacramento que ocurre en cada Misa: "He aquí el Cordero de Dios, he aquí el que quita los pecados del mundo. Bienaventurados los llamados a la cena del Cordero". La exposición del Santísimo Sacramento fluye del sacrificio de la Misa y sirve para profundizar nuestra hambre de comunión con Cristo y el resto de la Iglesia. El rito concluye con el ministro ordenado bendiciendo a los fieles con el Santísimo Sacramento.

Las horas santas son la tradición devocional católica romana de pasar una hora en adoración eucarística en presencia del Santísimo Sacramento. Los obispos han creado una variedad de horas santas que enfocan nuestra oración a Jesucristo en la paz, la vida, las vocaciones y otros temas que están en el corazón de la vida de la Iglesia y del mundo. Papas recientes han instado a los católicos a retomar la antigua práctica de la oración ante el Santísimo Sacramento.

Por favor, elija una hora para estar con el Señor en adoración en nuestra pequeña capilla y ayúdenos a alcanzar la meta de la **Adoración Perpetua** en St Regis.
