**THOUGHTS FROM FR. EMMANUEL**

This weekend we celebrate our Patron Saint, John Francis Regis.

St Regis (1597-1640) ministered to Catholics suffering neglect after civil conflicts. Much of southern France had fallen under control of the Huguenots who destroyed Catholic churches and killed the priests. St Regis longed to travel to the New World and become a missionary to the Native Americans, but he was called instead to work among his own compatriots. St Regis had the task of bringing faith in God and to rekindle the light of Christ in France.

It is important to follow this example of courage in our mission to bring the love of God to our neighbors so everyone may come back to communion with Christ and his Church.

Also, this weekend we give thanks to God for all Fathers living and those in heaven and we pray that God may continue blessing them for the tremendous love they have for us and for the many ways they have blessed us in our lives. Happy Father's Day.
