THOUGHTS FROM FR. EMMANUEL

Friends,
today's Gospel offers evidence of Jesus' power and authority as he calms the storm. In his day, power over nature was believed to be a sign of divinity—only God calms storms. Jesus' rebuke of the storm also echoes the rebuke he uses when he talks to and expels demons. In each situation, Jesus' power and authority is a sign of his divinity.

This Gospel is a metaphor for our lives. We are in the boat, the storms of life are raging around us, and like the disciples, we may believe that Jesus is unconcerned, or "sleeping." We hope that we will be as familiar with Jesus as his disciples. If we feel that Jesus is sleeping, are we comfortable enough to wake Jesus and present him with our needs? Jesus does not chide his disciples for waking him. Instead, he chides them for their lack of faith, for their lack of perspective. When we bring our worries to God in prayer, we might just begin to learn to see things from God's perspective.

Thanks to all who made possible the St Regis Day to be a wonderful blessing!

PENSAMIENTOS DEL P. EMMANUEL

Amigos,
El Evangelio de hoy ofrece evidencia del poder y la autoridad de Jesús mientras calma la tormenta. En su época, se creía que el poder sobre la naturaleza era un signo de divinidad: solo Dios calma las tormentas. La reprensión de Jesús a la tormenta también se hace eco de la reprensión que usa cuando habla con los demonios y los expulsa. En cada situación, el poder y la autoridad de Jesús son un signo de su divinidad.

Este Evangelio es una metáfora de nuestras vidas. Estamos en la barca, las tormentas de la vida se desenvuelven a nuestro alrededor y, al igual que los discípulos, podemos creer que Jesús no está preocupado, o que está "durmiendo". Esperamos estar tan familiarizados con Jesús como sus discípulos. Si sentimos que Jesús está durmiendo, ¿nos sentimos lo suficientemente cómodos como para despertarlo y presentarle nuestras necesidades? Jesús no reprende a sus discípulos por despertarlo. En cambio, los reprende por su falta de fe, por su falta de perspectiva. Cuando llevamos nuestras preocupaciones a Dios en oración, es posible que comencemos a aprender a ver las cosas desde la perspectiva de Dios.
