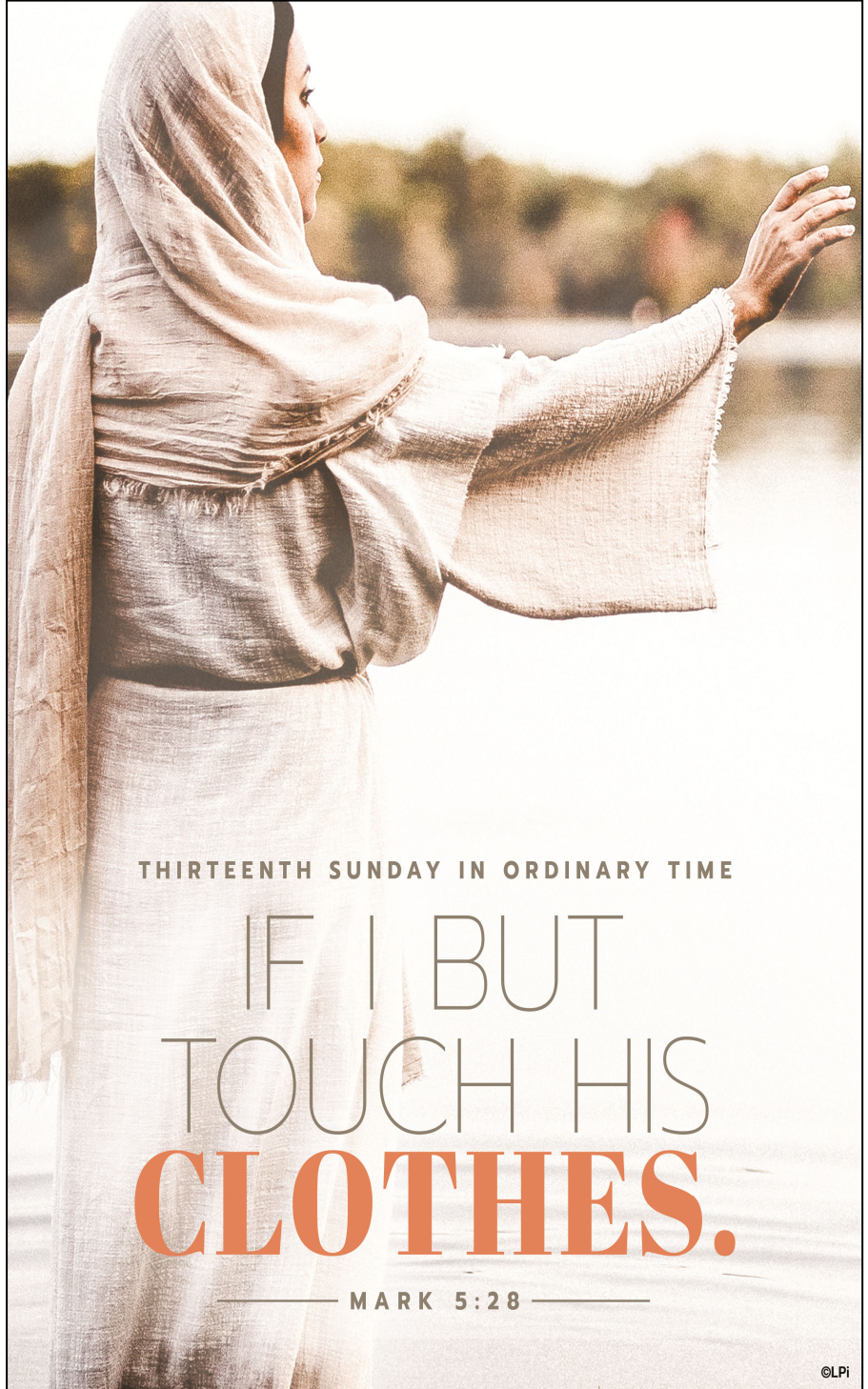

Friends,

In today's Gospel we see that touched by Jairus' humble and urgent plea Jesus proceeded to make his way to Jairus' house. But little did he know, as he and Jesus pushed their way through the crowd, that there was a woman in the crowd who needed Jesus just as much as he did and that she was also pushing through the crowd. She, unlike Jairus, was an unimportant, nameless, weak, poor, and a suffering woman.

Both, the woman and the girl, received a miracle of love, the proof of the power of Jesus the Lord. This is a reminder that, at some time in our lives, we all could find ourselves in overwhelming situations that we do not know how to deal with. It might be a personal illness or life-threatening illness of a family member or unexpected death of a loved one or a case of serious depression. Just as the saying goes, "desperate times call for desperate measures"; hence, desperate situations call for desperate faith. Faith in itself is meaningless, but faith in the all-powerful God means everything, transforms everything, and restores everything.



Amigos

En el Evangelio de hoy vemos que, conmovido por la humilde y urgente súplica de Jairo, Jesús procedió a dirigirse a la casa de Jairo. Pero poco sabía, mientras él y Jesús se abrían paso entre la multitud, que había una mujer en la multitud que necesitaba a Jesús tanto como él y que ella también se estaba abriendo paso entre la multitud. Ella, a diferencia de Jairo, era una mujer sin importancia, sin nombre, débil, pobre y sufriente.

Ambas, la mujer y la niña, recibieron un milagro de amor, la prueba del poder de Jesús el Señor. Esto es un recordatorio de que, en algún momento de nuestras vidas, todos podríamos encontrarnos en situaciones abrumadoras que no sabemos cómo afrontar. Puede ser una enfermedad personal o una enfermedad potencialmente mortal de un miembro de la familia o la muerte inesperada de un ser querido o un caso de depresión grave. Como dice el refrán, "los tiempos desesperados requieren medidas desesperadas"; Por lo tanto, las situaciones desesperadas exigen una fe desesperada. La fe en sí misma no tiene sentido, pero la fe en el Dios todopoderoso lo significa todo, todo lo transforma y todo lo restaura.
