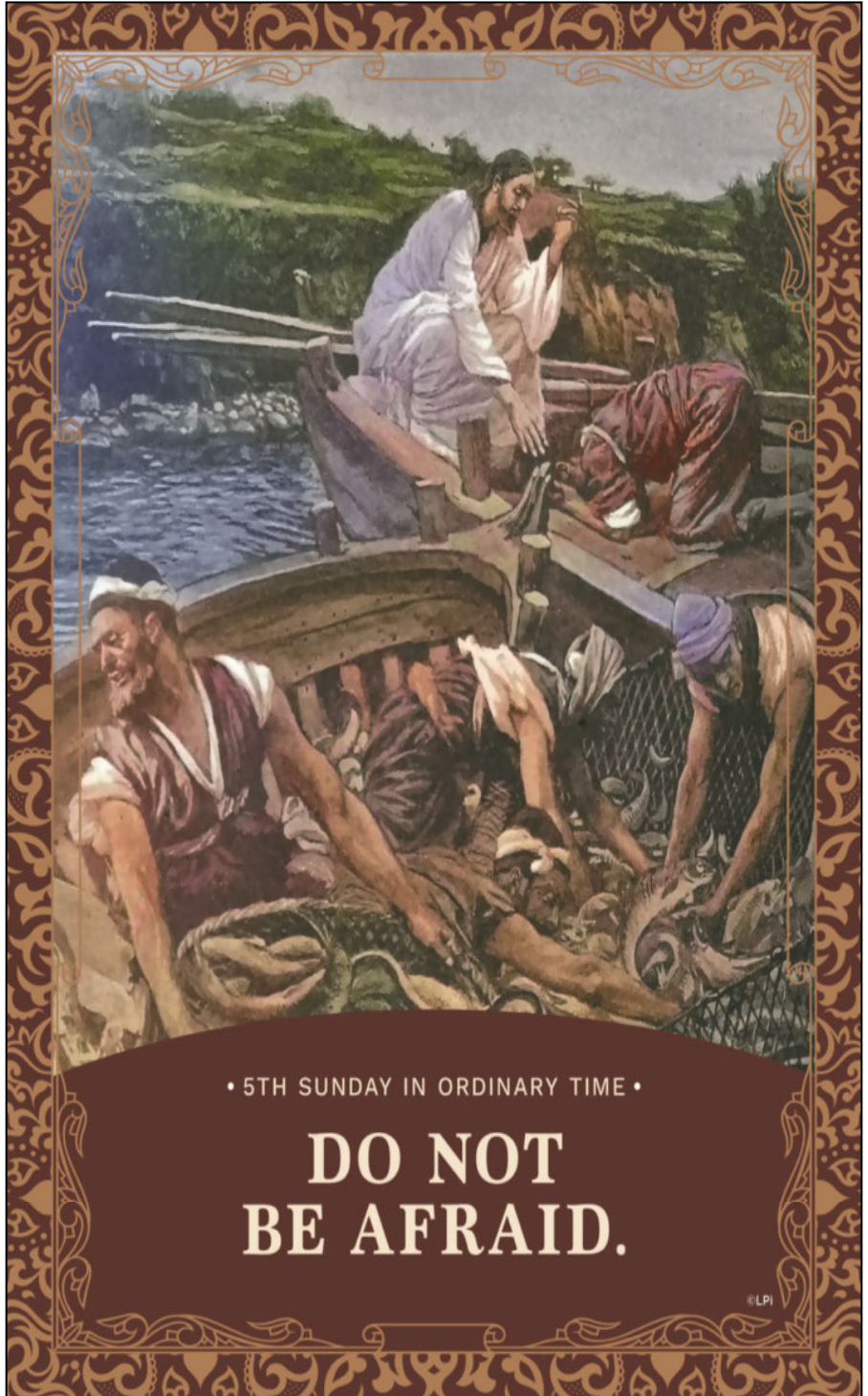

**THOUGHTS FROM FR. EMMANUEL**

**Called by Name Weekend!!**

Friends the Gospel of Christ teaches us how to leave everything to Follow Him. The miraculous catch of fish and the call of Peter illustrate God’s ability to transform the ordinary into the extraordinary. It highlights the courage needed to follow a vocation and how families can encourage and support this willingness to follow Christ’s call.

Priests play a vital role in journeying with young men who are discerning the call to the priesthood. The discernment process extends beyond evaluating external qualities and skills; it involves a profound interior journey of listening to God’s voice. The priest's task is to guide these men as they seek to understand God’s will for their lives, helping them grow in virtue, deepen their relationship with Christ, and discern a potential call to the priesthood.

This “Called by Name Weekend” invites us to identify who may have a priestly vocation in our church, offering a comprehensive framework for identifying the qualities to look for in a seminary candidate. Helping young men in our community to discern their vocation by encouraging the development of genuine friendships, a life of personal prayer, active participation in the sacramental life of the Church, and a commitment to serving the parish community. This new ministry involves supporting these men not only in spiritual and pastoral growth but also in intellectual, emotional, and human formation.

Let’s nominate our parish men and let us help them to answer God’s call.

Finally, next weekend we will offer a special blessing for married couples as we approach the celebration of the World’s Week of Marriage and also Valentine’s Day this week.

Following is a personal testimony shared by Cassandra Lewis

As some of you know, I have struggled with increasing depression for many years. I've tried adoration and saying the rosary with a group on Tuesday evenings. My prayers to God became begging for relief until finally all I could say was "Lord Jesus Christ, please forgive me for I am a sinner" over and over while tears ran down my face. I felt no relief in prayer, but I kept trying. I saw several different doctors; my Primary Care Physician (PCP), an Ear, Nose, & Throat specialist, mental health therapists and two (2) psychiatrists. I tried group therapy and Transglobal Magnetic Stimulation (TMS), and nothing seemed to work, but I kept trying.

After many odd symptoms, I had an episode of amnesia and my PCP ordered an MRI. The MRI indicated a benign brain tumor in my forehead which was causing the vast majority of my symptoms. The tumor was removed, and my prayer life changed. Instead of asking for forgiveness over and over, I opened myself up to God's love and blessings. I have been full of thanksgiving and love for my fellow man. I have deep thoughts, and even conversations, with God and those that have gone before me. While I still ask for forgiveness for my sins, this is not central to my prayer life...it is LOVE of GOD and my fellow man where I now focus. It's been a weight off of my shoulders and my soul - and all because of a benign brain tumor and God's grace in my life and in everyone else's! I will keep trying to improve this aspect of my life in my journey to find GOD'S LOVE So, I ask each of you to please keep trying! You will find HIM and HIS LOVE!
