

Following is a testimony shared by Glen Ernstmann.

I was not engaged with my faith as a child nor as a teenager. When I was 12 years old my father died of a heart attack, so my mom had four children to raise by herself; I did nothing to help her with this trial. I got caught up in the "hippy" era and was into drugs, alcohol and misbehavior. When I went to college, I decided to straighten my life out, but it was harder than I expected and I had something of a nervous breakdown and actually prayed toi God, maybe for the first time, for some sort of relief. I decided I needed to leave my party friends behind. I made a general confession and started going to church. I started reading about the saints and studying about the Church teachings and I married a wonderful Catholi lady who has encouraged me to live a Christ-centered life. It's been a slow transition over the past 50 years, but I am gradually giving my life to God - and I'm very glad about
