**THOUGHTS FROM FR. EMMANUEL**  
 2025 is the Jubilee Holy Year, the 2,025th anniversary of the Incarnation of our Lord, an "event of great spiritual, ecclesial, and social significance in the life of the Church." The concept of "Jubilee" has its origins in the Book of Leviticus (chapter 25) as a special year of reconciliation, pilgrimage, and coming home. Pope Francis has designated the 2025 Holy Year as a time to renew ourselves as "Pilgrims of Hope."

St. Regis Parish and Academy will live this Lenten experience of HOPE through Wednesday reflections, Sunday and daily homilies, adoration, talks, Friday stations of the Cross, etc...

At the end of our preparation, we will go on a Car-pilgrimage to the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception Downtown KC to gain the plenary Indulgence passing through the Holy Door (main doors of the Cathedral) on Thursday, April 10<sup>th</sup> any time between 5pm to 6pm and then we will have Holy Mass with Bishop Johnston and all the priests of the diocese at 7pm. **LENT: FAST & ABSTINENCE**

The following guidelines are provided by the Diocese: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of **Fast and Abstinence** and all the Fridays of Lent are days of Abstinence. Abstinence is from meat by Catholics 14 years and older. Fasting is by all Catholics 18 years of age but not yet 59. Those bound by this rule may take one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted as necessary to maintain strength according to one’s needs, but eating solid food between meals is not permitted.

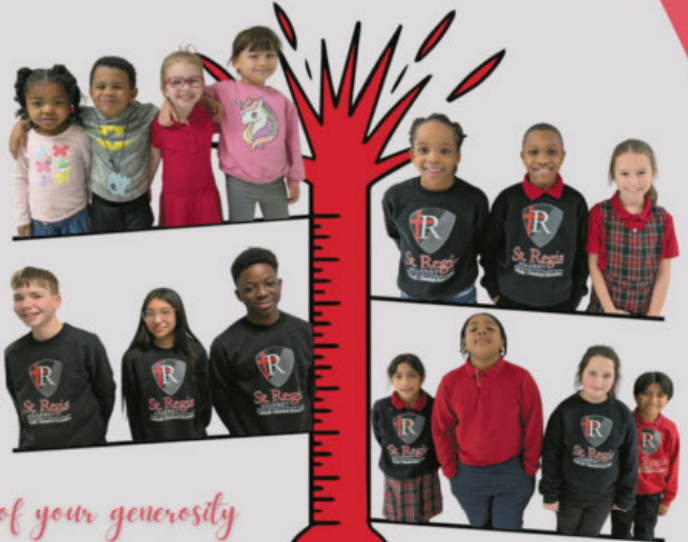
