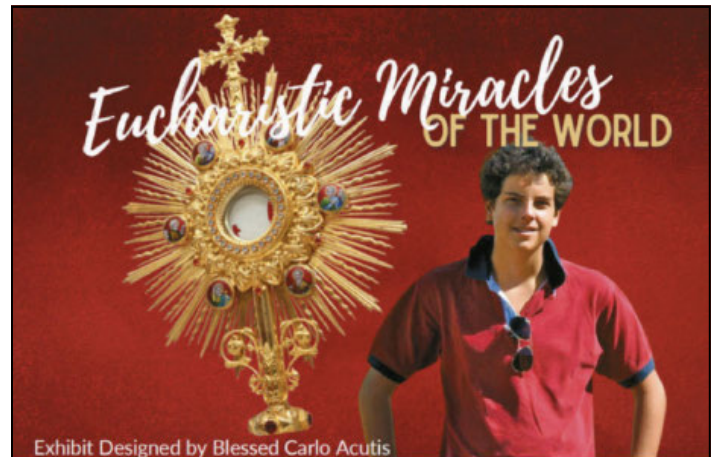
FATHER'S DAY

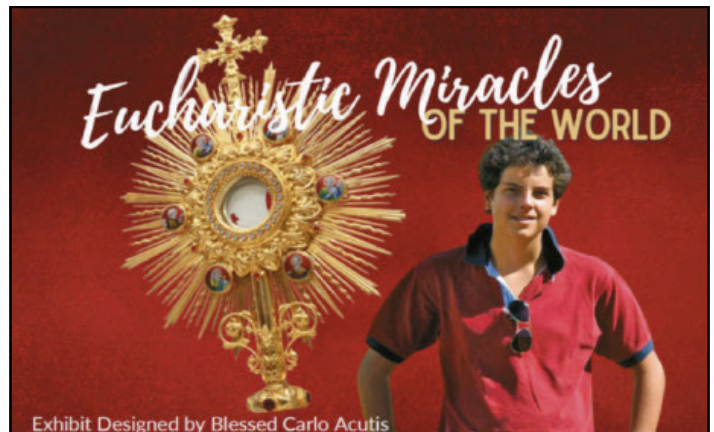
