THOUGHTS FROM FR. EMMANUEL

Friends,

As Jesus continues his journey to Jerusalem, he is confronted by a scholar of the law who wants to test him. In the Gospels of Mark and Matthew, Jesus is asked about the greatest commandment. Here, in Luke's Gospel, the lawyer asks what we must do to inherit eternal life.

In the other two Gospels, Jesus answers the question by quoting Deuteronomy 6:5, on loving God with all your heart, and Leviticus 19:18, on loving your neighbor. Here Jesus asks the expert to answer this question, "What is written in the law?" The man is caught and responds with Deuteronomy 6:5. This verse is one of the most important prayers in Judaism, and it was said twice a day in Jesus' time. Love of God and love of neighbor are what is required for eternal life. Jesus' response is simple, "Do this and you will live."

Having been shown up by Jesus, the lawyer tries another question: Who is my neighbor whom I must love like myself? In the society of Jesus' time, with its distinctions between Jews and Gentiles, men and women, clean and unclean, this was a trick question. Jesus responds with one of the most beautiful of all the parables, the Good Samaritan. It is found only in Luke's Gospel.

When Jesus asks the lawyer who was the neighbor in the story, the lawyer can't bring himself to say it was the Samaritan. All he says is that it was "the one who treated him with mercy." Jesus' response was similar to that of the first discussion: "Go and do likewise." The lawyer, and we, know what is right. The key is to do it.

PENSAMIENTOS DEL P. EMMANUEL

Amigos

Mientras Jesús continúa su viaje a Jerusalén, se enfrenta a un erudito de la ley que quiere ponerlo a prueba. En los Evangelios de Marcos y Mateo, se le pregunta a Jesús sobre el mandamiento más grande. Aquí, en el Evangelio de Lucas, el intérprete de la ley pregunta qué debemos hacer para heredar la vida eterna.

En los otros dos Evangelios, Jesús responde a la pregunta citando Deuteronomio 6:5, sobre amar a Dios con todo el corazón, y Levítico 19:18, sobre amar al prójimo. Aquí Jesús le pide al experto que responda a esta pregunta: "¿Qué está escrito en la ley?" El hombre es atrapado y responde con Deuteronomio 6:5. Este versículo es una de las oraciones más importantes del judaísmo, y se decía dos veces al día en la época de Jesús. El amor a Dios y el amor al prójimo es lo que se requiere para la vida eterna. La respuesta de Jesús es simple: "Haz esto y vivirás".

Una vez que Jesús se le ha presentado, el intérprete de la ley intenta otra pregunta: ¿Quién es mi prójimo a quien debo amar como a mí mismo? En la sociedad de la época de Jesús, con sus distinciones entre judíos y gentiles, hombres y mujeres, limpios e impuros, esta era una pregunta capciosa. Jesús responde con una de las más bellas de todas las parábolas, el Buen Samaritano. Solo se encuentra en el Evangelio de Lucas.

Cuando Jesús le pregunta al abogado quién era el vecino de la historia, el abogado no se atreve a decir que era el samaritano. Todo lo que dice es que fue "el que lo trató con misericordia". La respuesta de Jesús fue similar a la de la primera conversación: "Ve y haz lo mismo". El abogado, y nosotros, sabemos lo que es correcto. La clave es hacerlo.

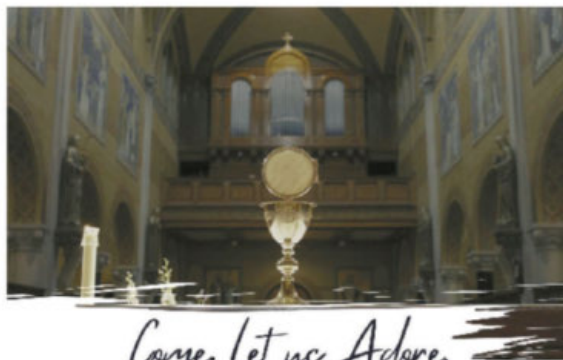
