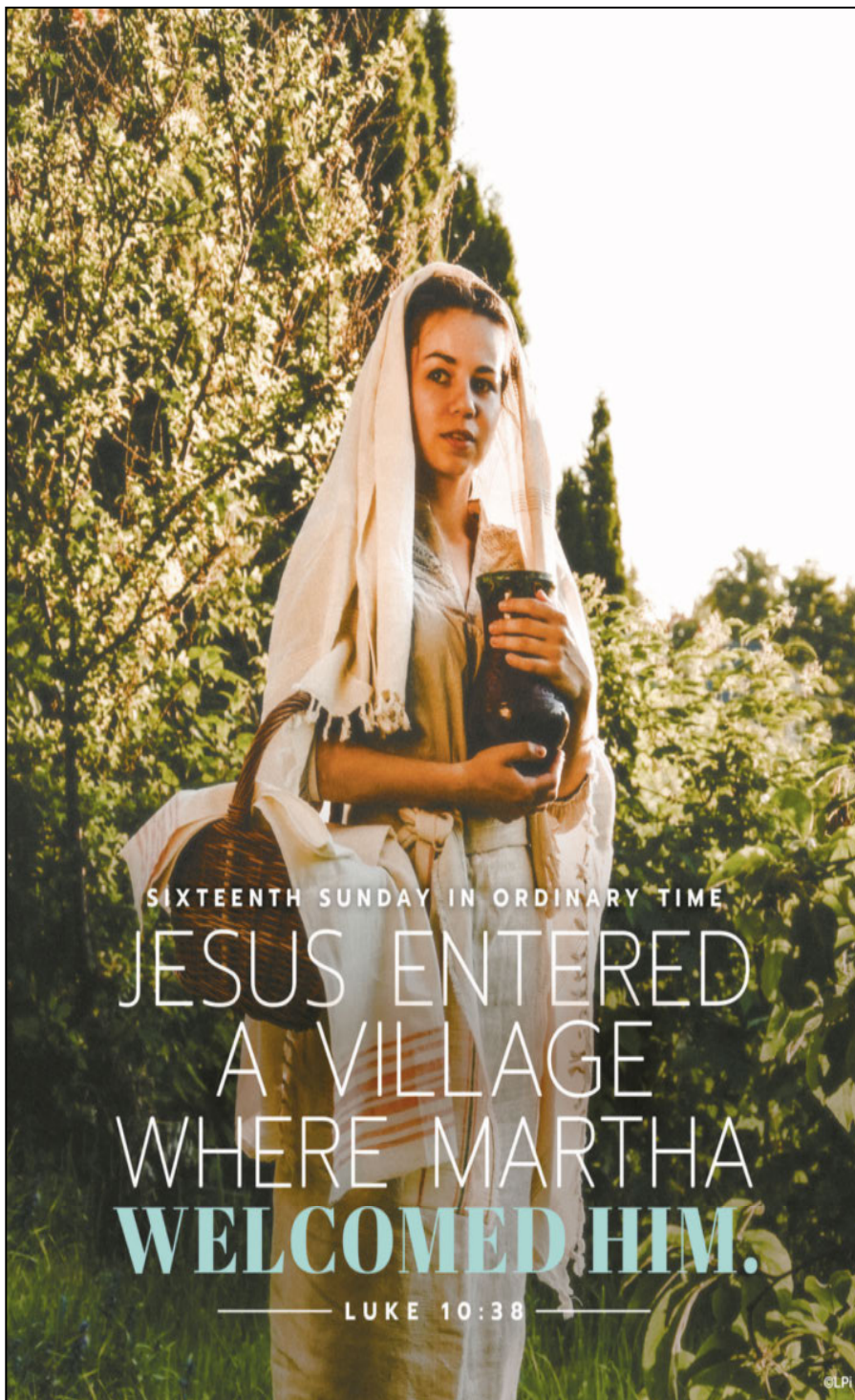

THOUGHTS FROM FR. EMMANUEL

Friends,

The readings for this Sunday present the theme of hospitality and although in the Gospel the guest is Jesus, the focus is on the behavior of the hosts. Like Abraham, Martha is busy about many things. Mary simply sits at Jesus' feet, listening to his words. Martha complains to Jesus that she is left with all the work and says, regarding the contemplative Mary, "Tell her to help me." Jesus chides Martha and defends Mary.

Christian tradition has applied this passage in discussions of the relative worth of active and contemplative lifestyles in the community of faith. Jesus' language about "need of only one thing" and "the better part" do lend themselves to that application. But the placement of the Samaritan parable (last Sunday's Gospel Reading) right before this one suggests that Luke does not intend this account as championing contemplation being superior to action. The point of Jesus' critique of Martha lies not in her activity but in her self-preoccupied comparison. Note that Martha refers to herself several times: "*My* sister has left *me* to do all the work by *myself*?" Tell her then to help *me*." Quite a lot of "me" "me" "me" and "my." Martha's generous hospitality has become more about *her* than about her guest.

In this case, the one thing necessary was attending to the guest—whether by cooking or by attentive listening. Martha's fault was to be distracted from the point of her activity—serving the guest, our Lord. Jesus is not going after Busy Martha, but Distracted and Resentful Martha.

Sitting at Jesus' feet is something Mary *chose* to do. We too must choose it over and over again, day in and day out, by saying "no" to other things so that we can say "yes" to the one necessary thing. The real activity to which God calls us, the important work of loving as Jesus loved, can only be sustained by the renewing power of the Holy Spirit that we tap into when we worship and pray and draw ourselves into the presence of God.

PENSAMIENTOS DEL P. EMMANUEL

Amigos

Las lecturas de este domingo presentan el tema de la hospitalidad y aunque en el Evangelio el invitado es Jesús, la atención se centra en el comportamiento de los anfitriones. Al igual que Abraham, Marta está ocupada en muchas cosas. María simplemente se sienta a los pies de Jesús, escuchando sus palabras. Marta se queja a Jesús de que se queda con todo el trabajo y le dice, refiriéndose a la contemplativa María: "Dile que me ayude". Jesús reprende a Marta y defiende a María.

La tradición cristiana ha aplicado este pasaje en las discusiones sobre el valor relativo de los estilos de vida activos y contemplativos en la comunidad de fe. El lenguaje de Jesús acerca de que "solo hay necesidad de una cosa" y "la mejor parte" se presta a esa aplicación. Pero la colocación de la parábola del samaritano (la lectura del Evangelio del domingo pasado) justo antes de esta sugiere que Lucas no tiene la intención de que este relato defienda que la contemplación es superior a la acción. El punto de la crítica de Jesús a Marta no radica en su actividad, sino en su comparación preocupada por sí misma. Nótese que Marta se refiere a sí misma varias veces: "*¿Mi hermana me ha dejado sola para hacer todo el trabajo?*" Dile, pues, que me ayude. Bastante de "yo", "yo", "yo" y "mi". La generosa hospitalidad de Martha se ha convertido más en *ella* que en su huésped.

En este caso, lo único necesario era atender al invitado, ya fuera cocinando o escuchando atentamente. La culpa de Marta fue distraerse del punto de su actividad: servir al huésped, nuestro Señor. Jesús no va tras la ocupada Marta, sino por la distraída y resentida Marta.

Sentarse a los pies de Jesús es algo que María *eligió* hacer. También nosotros debemos elegirlo una y otra vez, día tras día, diciendo "no" a otras cosas para poder decir "sí" a la única cosa necesaria. La verdadera actividad a la que Dios nos llama, la importante obra de amar como Jesús amó, solo puede ser sostenida por el poder renovador del Espíritu Santo al que accedemos cuando adoramos, oramos y nos acercamos a la presencia de Dios.
