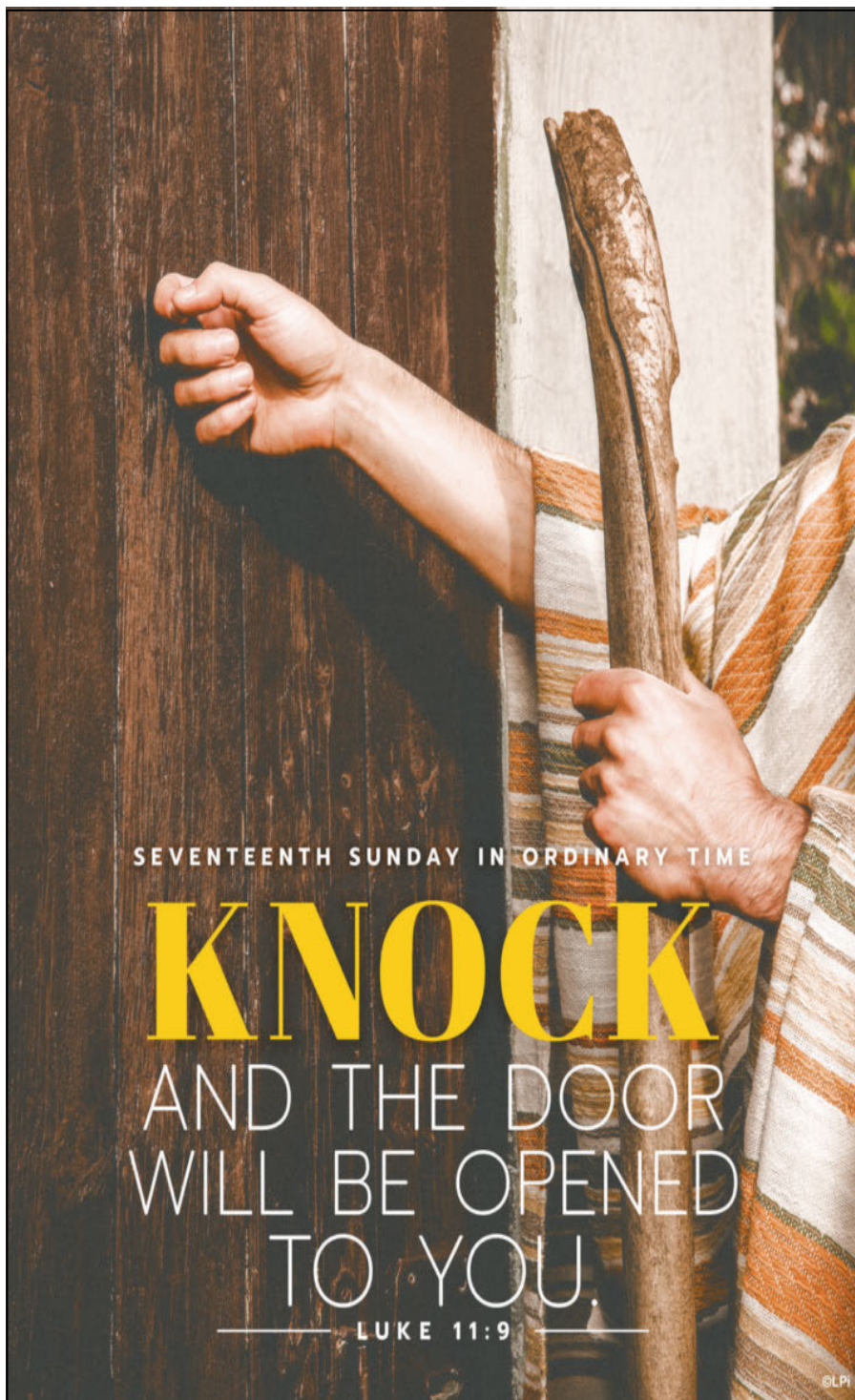

THOUGHTS FROM FR. EMMANUEL

Friends,

The Gospel for this weekend helps us to question ourselves: How do we pray, when do we pray, how often do we pray, do we pray at all?...Do we see prayer as a necessary part of our life...or do we pray only when we want something. All gets back to the importance of God in our lives.

St. Teresa of Avila sees prayer as an “intimate sharing between friends,” it is not just recitation of words but a living contact with Jesus, a gradual process of growth culminating in union with God. Her prayer life was centered on Christ’s presence, both in the Eucharist and in the believer’s heart. She encouraged a desire for union with Jesus in prayer and contemplation.

In prayer we are invited into a relationship with a loving God who wants to give us life and to keep on bringing our needs and concerns to God because he tells us to trust in his loving presence.

So as we begin our prayer time each day let us ask, “Lord, teach us to pray.”

“Let nothing disturb you, let nothing frighten you, all things pass away, God never changes, patience obtains all things, those who have God, find they lack nothing. God alone suffices.”
