## THOUGHTS FROM FR. EMMANUEL

Friends,

Meet our new parishioners “Sisters Poor of Jesus Christ.”

Everything began in São Paulo in 2001. There, Fr. Gilson, their Founder, encountered the reality of youth marked by the dramas of those who live on the periphery of the largest city of Brazil: poverty, trafficking, crack, alcohol, violence, unemployment, shattered families...

The spiritual solution that he sought, was to hold retreats for these young adults, and through personal contact with them where they could be found—in the places where drug sales and use were high. This alone, however, was not sufficient to help them. So the founders, Fr. Gilson and Sonya (who later became Sister Servant), made the decision together with some young people, to rent a house which would welcome and shelter young adults who wanted to escape drugs and violence.

In 2011 the Community, after 10 years of foundation and guided by Dom Pedro Luiz Strighini, receives in the diocese of Franca the first step of canonical recognition.

At that time the community had already spread over Brazil and abroad. Their first mission in the North American was open in January and received the first sisters, in the Archdiocese of Kansas City, KS. Archbishop Joseph F. Naumann received in his archdiocese the three first sisters sent in mission to American soil. At the beginning of this year a team of sisters moved to a new address within the boundaries of St. Regis becoming our new parishioners.

As any other parishioners they will come regularly to St. Regis to receive the sacraments and when available they will help us to grow in faith through their Charism. Please, meet and welcome the sisters on the weekend of August 23 & 24 at all the masses! (bring extra cash as they will set up their religious gift shop).

## PENSAMIENTOS DEL P. EMMANUEL

Amigos

Conozca a nuestros nuevos feligreses "Hermanas Pobres de Jesucristo".

Todo comenzó en São Paulo en 2001. Allí, el P. Gilson, su Fundador, se encontró con la realidad de la juventud marcada por los dramas de quienes viven en la periferia de la ciudad más grande de Brasil: pobreza, tráfico, crack, alcohol, violencia, desempleo, familias destrozadas...

La solución espiritual que buscó fue realizar retiros para estos jóvenes adultos y, a través del contacto personal con ellos, donde se pudieran encontrar, en los lugares donde las ventas y el uso de drogas eran altos. Sin embargo, esto por sí solo no fue suficiente para ayudarlos. Así que los fundadores, el P. Gilson y Sonya (que más tarde se convirtió en Hermana Sierva), tomaron la decisión junto con algunos jóvenes, de alquilar una casa que acogiera y albergara a jóvenes adultos que quisieran escapar de las drogas y la violencia.

En 2011 la Comunidad, después de 10 años de fundación y guiada por Dom Pedro Luiz Strighini, recibe en la diócesis de Franca el primer paso del reconocimiento canónico.

En ese momento, la comunidad ya se había extendido por Brasil y en el extranjero. Su primera misión en América del Norte se abrió en enero y recibió a las primeras hermanas, en la Arquidiócesis de Kansas City, KS. El arzobispo Joseph F. Naumann recibió en su arquidiócesis a las tres primeras hermanas enviadas en misión a suelo estadounidense. A principios de este año, un equipo de hermanas se mudó a una nueva dirección dentro de los límites de St. Regis convirtiéndose en nuestras nuevas feligresas.

Como cualquier otro feligrés, vendrán regularmente a St. Regis para recibir los sacramentos y, cuando estén disponibles, nos ayudarán a crecer en la fe a través de su carisma. ¡Por favor, conozca y dé la bienvenida a las hermanas el fin de semana del 23 y 24 de agosto en todas las misas! (traiga dinero extra ya que instalarán su tienda de regalos religiosos).
