**THOUGHTS FROM FR. EMMANUEL**

Friends,

This Sunday we are reminded that true wisdom consists in seeking and fulfilling God's Will for us. If we are to fulfill His Divine Will in our life, if we want to follow Christ, we must be ready to renounce everything which could constitute as an obstacle to follow Jesus. Our Lord reminds us in the Gospel (Lk 14: 25-33) that:

"Whoever does not bear his own cross and come after me, cannot be my disciple... So therefore, whoever of you does not renounce all that he has cannot be my disciple".

The word "hate" towards our loved ones must not be interpreted literally. It must be understood, in the context of all our Lord's teachings (cf. Lk 6:27.35). Using a hyperbolic expression, Our Lord simply reminds that when it comes to loving God, we cannot be half-hearted. God must take priority over everything, even above our own preferences, because it is the only way to fulfill His Will, convinced that God knows and wants the best for each one of us. As St. Gregory the Great comments:

"In this world let us love everyone, even though he be our enemy; but let us hate him who opposes us on our way to God, though he be our relative.... We should, then, love our neighbor; we should have charity towards all; towards relatives and towards strangers, but without separating ourselves from the love of God out of love for them"

Next week the Lay Missionaries Servants of the Word will introduce themselves to all of us after the weekend masses. Please take a moment to welcome them to St. Regis.

## PENSAMIENTOS DEL P. EMMANUEL

Amigos

Este domingo se nos recuerda que la verdadera sabiduría consiste en buscar y cumplir la Voluntad de Dios para nosotros. Si queremos cumplir su Divina Voluntad en nuestra vida, si queremos seguir a Cristo, debemos estar dispuestos a renunciar a todo lo que pueda constituir un obstáculo para seguir a Jesús. Nuestro Señor nos recuerda en el Evangelio (Lc 14, 25-33) que:

"El que no lleva su propia cruz y viene en pos de mí, no puede ser mi discípulo... Por tanto, cualquiera de vosotros que no renuncie a todo lo que tiene, no puede ser mi discípulo".

La palabra "odio" hacia nuestros seres queridos no debe interpretarse literalmente. Debe entenderse, en el contexto de todas las enseñanzas de nuestro Señor (cf. Lc 6,27.35). Usando una expresión hiperbólica, Nuestro Señor simplemente recuerda que cuando se trata de amar a Dios, no podemos ser poco entusiastas. Dios debe tener prioridad sobre todo, incluso por encima de nuestras propias preferencias, porque es la única manera de cumplir su Voluntad, convencido de que Dios sabe y quiere lo mejor para cada uno de nosotros. Como comenta San Gregorio Magno:

"En este mundo amemos a todos, aunque sea nuestro enemigo; sino odiamos a aquel que se opone a nosotros en nuestro camino hacia Dios, aunque sea nuestro pariente... Debemos, entonces, amar a nuestro prójimo; debemos tener caridad hacia todos; hacia los parientes y hacia los extraños, pero sin separarnos del amor de Dios por amor a ellos"


