THOUGHTS FROM FR. EMMANUEL

Friends,

This Sunday's liturgy reminds us that God brings light into darkness. We hear the words of Isaiah about a people who once lived in gloom but now see light. This reading shows us that God does not leave us alone. He is near, even in hard times.

In the Gospel, Jesus begins preaching and calling his first followers. He brings light to Galilee. He tells them to turn their lives around and follow him. His message is simple but clear: the kingdom of heaven is close.

Saint Paul also speaks to the early Church. He tells them to stop fighting and focus on Jesus. It is a good reminder for us today. We belong to Christ, not to any group or leader. We belong to Christ, and we must know and experience that Jesus brings hope, healing, and peace. He calls each of us to follow him and live in his light.

We begin Catholic Schools Week inviting you to pray and support our scholars and teachers and to participate in all the activities we have during this week.


