



CONSECRATION TO THE SACRED HEART

In 1765, the devotion to the Sacred Heart was officially approved by Rome, and, in 1856, the feast of the Sacred Heart was made a universal solemnity by Pope Pius IX. By 1899, Pope Leo XIII composed an Act of Consecration that dedicated the entire human race to the Sacred Heart. In his 1956 encyclical *Haurietis Aquas*, Pope Pius XII wrote, “It is altogether impossible to enumerate the heavenly gifts which devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus has poured out on the souls of the faithful, purifying them, offering them heavenly strength, rousing them to the attainment of all virtues.”


