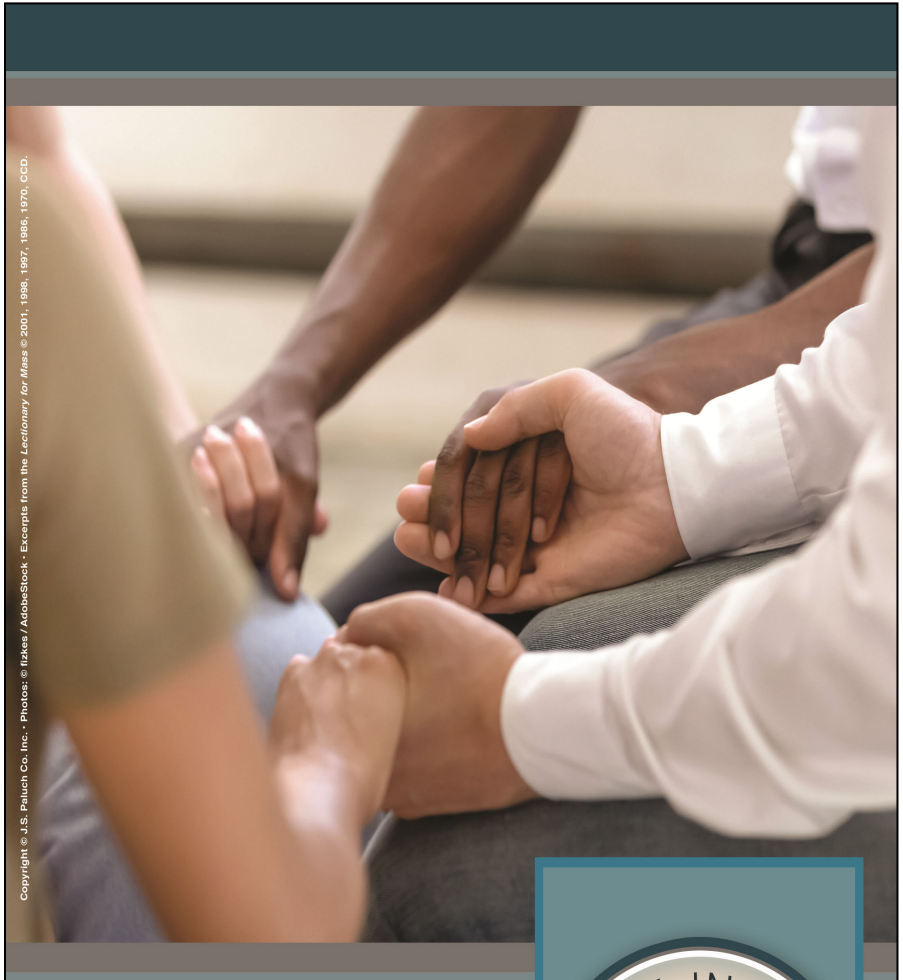

**LENT: FAST & ABSTINENCE**

The following guidelines are provided by the Diocese: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of **Fast and Abstinence** and all the Fridays of Lent are days of Abstinence. Abstinence is from meat by Catholics 14 years and older. Fasting is by all Catholics 18 years of age but not yet 59. Those bound by this rule may take one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted as necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid food between meals is not permitted.

### WHAT IS THE RITE OF ELECTION?

This Rite marks a key moment! For catechumens (unbaptized), the Rite signifies that they have been called by Christ and attests to the reality that only those mystically claimed by Christ will enter heaven. St John writes *“If anyone’s name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire.”* (Rev 20:15). The parish community, represented by the sponsors, affirms that these pilgrims are ready to join the Catholic Church. The decision of an OCIA participant to go through the Rite means that the decision-making period has ended: the catechumens are henceforth referred to as the “Elect” and have been chosen to enter the final period of preparation for initiation and are called by the bishop to enter into the Pascal Mystery at Easter. Candidates, those already baptized, are part of the Elect and so do not directly participate in the Rite of Election. However, as part of the liturgy, they are Called to Continuing Conversion and their intention to be fully initiated and share in the Eucharist is recognized.

### PERPETUAL ADORATION

St. Regis' goal is to have someone praying before the Blessed Sacrament every hour of every week. We can do it, but we need your help. Please consider which hour works best for your schedule and sign up after all the Masses **February 25 and 26**. Sign up for Lent, then make it a regular habit. It is impossible to describe the personal and parish blessings God the Father will bestow on a parish family who puts spending only 1 hour with Jesus each week the highest priority. After all, you are His highest priority. Amazing graces are there for the taking!

### RECONCILIATION SERVICE

Make plan now to celebrate the Sacrament of Confession during the season of Lent. All of us are encouraged to join in this sacrament of God’s forgiveness in preparation for Easter. The St. Regis/St. Catherine of Siena/Coronation Reconciliation Service will be on **Wednesday, March 29**, at 6:30pm at Coronation of Our Lady in Grandview, MO. **There will be NO Adoration and Confession at St. Regis on that day.**
