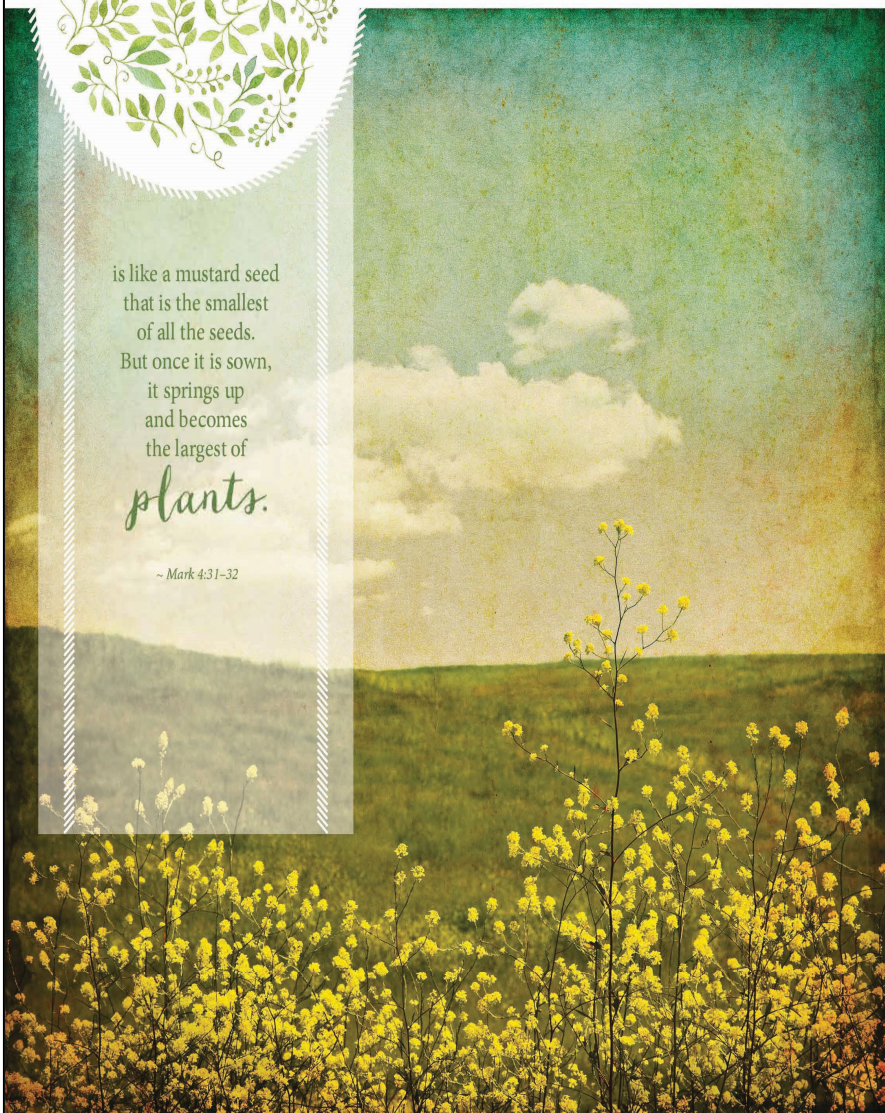

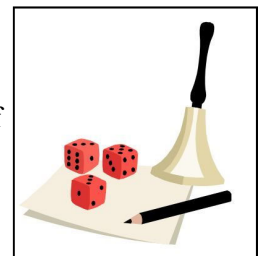


LADIES BUNCO
