
ST. REGIS STEWARDSHIP CORNER

Friends, I am Fr. Emmanuel G. Lopez, originally from Mexico City. At the age of fifteen, I met some young missionaries who were serving at my home parish, they invited me to join the youth group and I went. They taught us biblical courses and we went through sacred scriptures to learn the great History of Salvation. Then we studied how to pray, the life in the Holy Spirit, and Sacraments.

In the group, we did our apostolate visiting the sick in hospitals; giving food and clothing to families in need, and the best thing, we visited a hospital of lepers. This was the humblest and most powerful experience I had in my vocation story that convinced me to answer God's call. Let me tell you more about this, first I didn't want to go because I thought -what if I'm not polite with these people, I don't want to hurt them ... but, motivated by my parents, (you know, Moms are always right and have encouraging words) I went to that place, and it was just wonderful. I was ready to bring them comfort, peace and share with them happiness but guess what? It didn't happen that way because they were who gave me peace, comfort, and happiness. God was there in all His splendor, calling me to be a missionary.

I started going to Mass every day in the mornings which I enjoyed a lot because my pastor at that time, Fr. Juan Valle is such a holy priest. Each day his homilies were just what I needed to hear. The Eucharist increased within me the desire to do more adoration to the blessed sacrament so I started doing one hour adoration every day. By this time, 2002, after I talked with my pastor who was my spiritual director as well, I was sure I was ready to enter the seminary and I made it. I joined a religious community called Missionaries Servants of the Word. I did all the regular studies in this seminary plus few years of missions all over my country and in Cuba. On April 2011, I had an accident, and my right foot was basically destroyed... reason why I left the seminary and joined again in 2014 but now as an incardinated member of the diocese of Kansas City-St. Joseph. I finished my formation at Kenrick-Glennon Seminary in St. Louis, MO. and was ordained as a priest on May 25th, 2019, at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Kansas City MO.

I spent my first year as a newly ordain priest in St. Thomas More South KC, then I was sent to serve Our Lady of the Presentation in Lee's Summit. Now the bishop has appointed me to serve you and I am blessed with this opportunity, and I am looking forward to meeting you.

Some of my hobbies are fishing, cooking, reading, swimming, and road trips. I love the outdoors! What people do not know about me: I took a two year class on mixology. I like any kind of food and love coffee.

My hope is that we can learn from each other and walk together in this path towards heaven.
