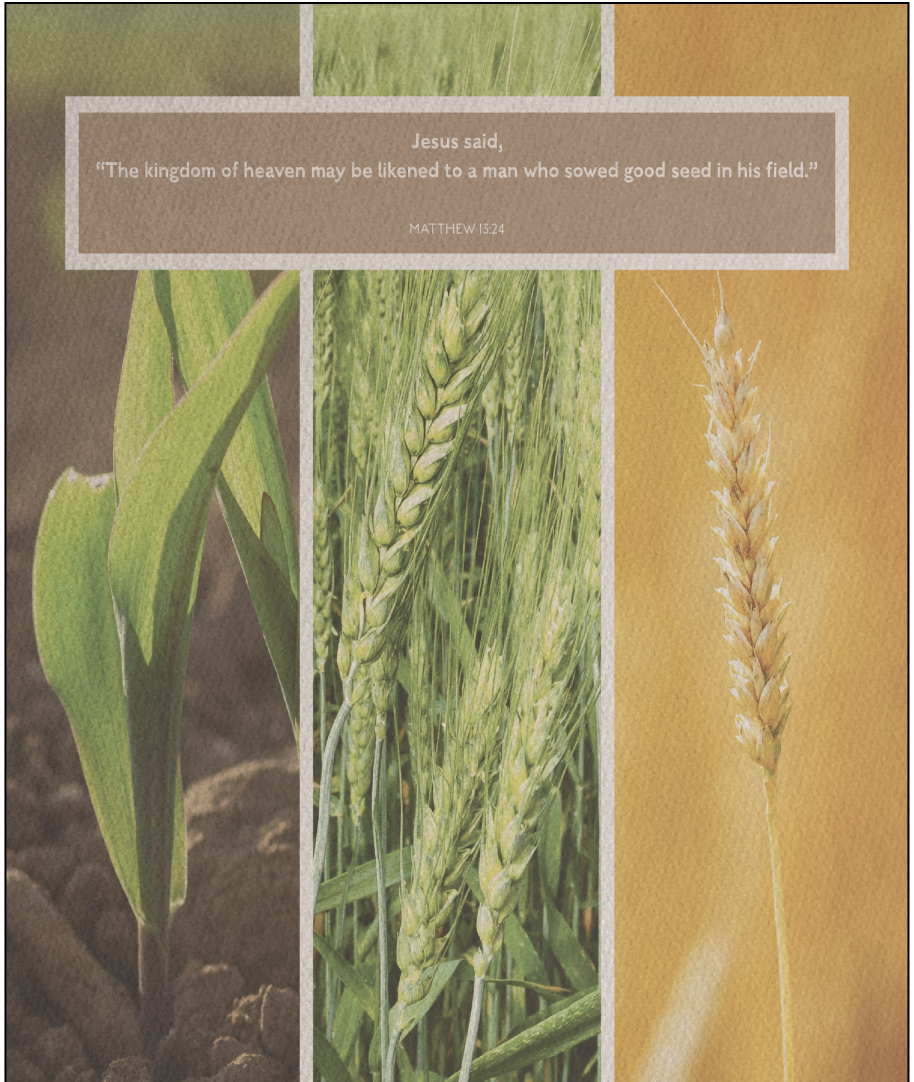

UNLOCK THE MYSTERIES OF THE BIBLE

In just 8 sessions, you will understand the story, the message and historical lessons of the bible. The 1-hour sessions will be on **Mondays beginning July 20 at 7pm**. We will meet in the parish hall with appropriate social distancing and virus avoidance measures. Look for the signup table after weekend masses. You will want the \$20 study guide. This is the updated version of Cavin's *Quick Journey Through the Bible*. If you haven't participated in that study, or if it's been awhile, come and get this refreshing new look at the bible; every Catholic should experience this!

Many people want to read the Bible because they know it is God's Word but give up because it is so complicated. The *Unlocking the Mystery of the Bible* study program helps you to get the "big picture" of the Bible by showing how fourteen narrative books of the Bible tell the complete story from Adam and Eve to Christ and the Church.

In this study, presenter Jeff Cavins will show you how to read the Bible so that you can actually understand it. Aided by a unique color-coded *Bible Timeline™* Chart that arranges the key people, places, and events of Scripture in chronological order, *Unlocking the Mystery of the Bible* will help you discover the story of salvation history and understand how you fit into God's plan.

The 8-session *Unlocking the Mystery of the Bible* study program includes video presentations that explore the twelve time periods of *The Bible Timeline* Chart.

ST. REGIS STEWARDSHIP CORNER

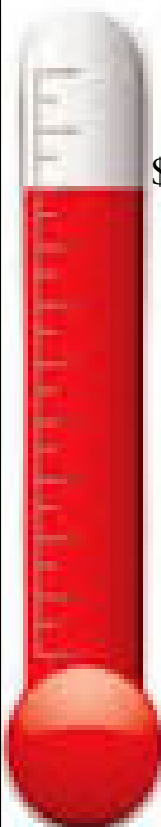

St. Regis Parish has a sister parish in ItaMaura, El Salvador? Our relationship with ItaMaura (monetary and prayer support) was established in 1992!! An important step in the fight for social justice is to improve the condition where the people currently live.

Monetarily we've helped in many ways: funded community electricity and water projects...supplied computers and other needed school supplies...bought an electric corn grinder...repurposed St. Regis school uniforms...and helped with various construction and repair projects for their church and community... to name a few.

Over these past 28 years a number of St. Regis delegations have visited ItaMaura. Two years ago our St. Regis delegation established an Education Endowment Fund through an organization called CIS (Centro de Intercambio y Solidaridad) Center for Exchange and Solidarity Scholarship Program.
