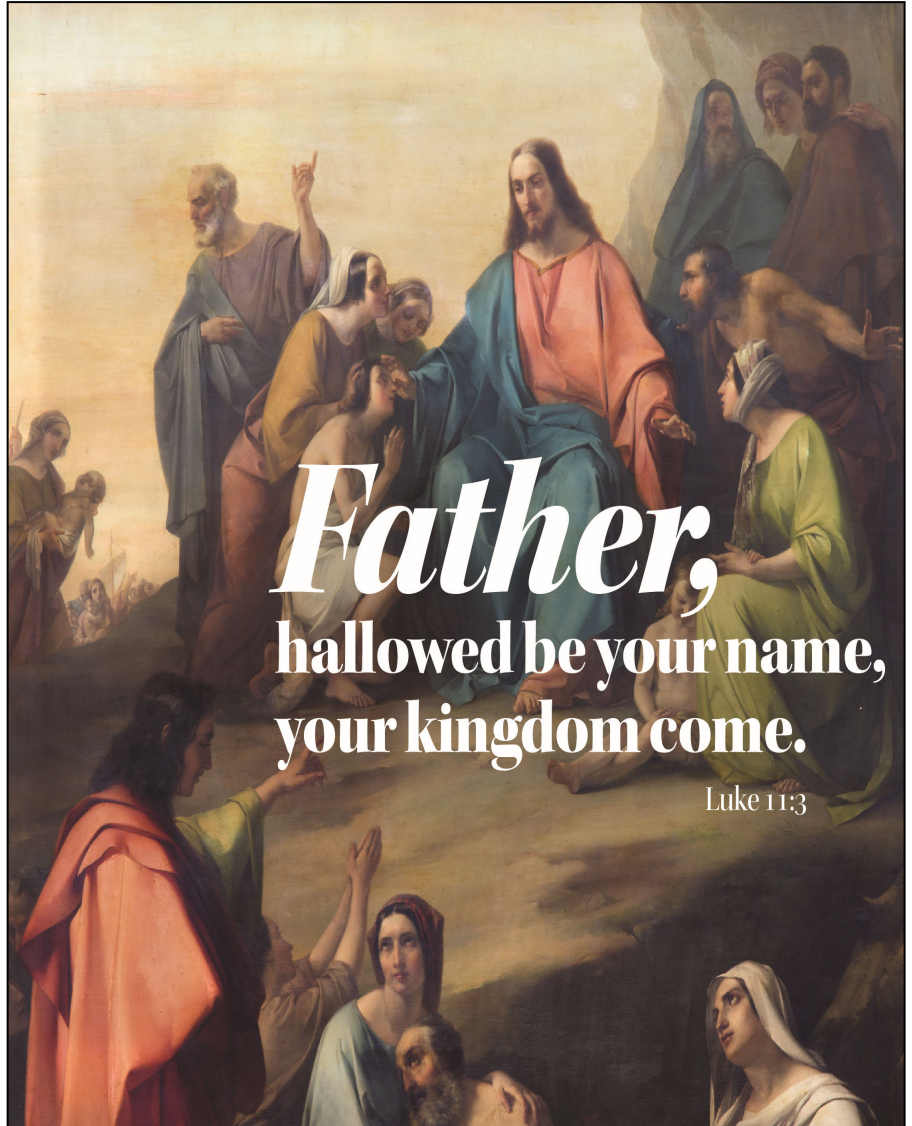

Good stewards realize the extraordinary love and graciousness with which God showers us. We need never convince God to be generous. God is already that generous friend. His abundant love bathes us in goodness. This week, prayerfully reflect on God's generosity to us. What should our response be to that generosity?

The Order Friar Servants of Mary (Servites) began their work in the Vicariate of Ingwavuma, Zululand, Natal, South Africa in 1948. The focus of Servite Mission Appeals in the United States has been the support of the daily ministry to the Zulu Catholics in the Vicariate and the evangelization of the non-Catholic. Missionaries today continue to proclaim the Gospel and establish Catholic communities. The Zulu people are the largest ethnic group in South Africa and the Catholics number 4.2%. They are proud, happy, strong, and hardworking people. Drought and adverse growing conditions have made it difficult for them to earn more than a meager living. The Church in Zululand needs your help in attaining the goals of its ministry.

Thank you for your ongoing support for all foreign missions. We thank you in advance for listening to the story of the Servites work among the Zulus in South Africa and in responding in what any way you can. We would like to thank you pastor and the Diocese of Kansas City/St. Joseph for allowing us to be part of the 2022 Missionary Cooperative plan. Fr. TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

Apart from the period from Thanksgiving through Christmas, the summer is a favored time for family reunions. We trace family trees and recall our origins. Worship has a family tree as well, and the way we celebrate today has been influenced by various styles and customs through the centuries. We are Western Christians of the Latin Rite. By far, we are the most numerous Western Christians, but there are other ritual families as well. The Archdiocese of Milan in Italy follows the Ambrosian Rite, Toledo in Spain preserves the Mozarabic Rite and the Arab language, and Lyons in France is home to the Gallican Rite. Other liturgical families, such as the Celtic in Ireland and the Sarum in England, faded away after the Reformation. Until recent times, members of some ancient religious orders such as Carmelites and Trappists followed a pattern of Mass that varied slightly from the plan observed in Latin Rite parishes.

Isn't the Catholic Church the same everywhere? Not at all. It never has been! The existence of so many liturgical families in the West reminds us that unity, not uniformity, is what the Church seeks to achieve among her children. We are united in faith, but wonderfully diverse in rituals, ceremonies, languages, customs, and spirituality.
