The focus of Servite Mission Appeals in the United States has been the support of the daily ministry to the Zulu Catholics in the Vicariate and the evangelization of the non-Catholic. Missionaries today continue to proclaim the Gospel and establish Catholic communities. The Zulu people are the largest ethnic group in South Africa and the Catholics number 4.2%. They are proud, happy, strong, and hardworking people. Drought and adverse growing conditions have made it difficult for them to earn more than a meager living. The Church in Zululand needs your help in attaining the goals of its ministry.

Thank you for your ongoing support for all foreign missions. We thank you in advance for listening to the story of the Servites work among the Zulus in South Africa and in responding in what any way you can. We would like to thank you pastor and the Diocese of Kansas City/St. Joseph for allowing us to be part of the 2022 Missionary Cooperative plan. Fr. In today's Gospel, Jesus offers a warning to those who pursue leisure and pleasure as their goal in life without concern for the poor and less fortunate. He tells the parable of the wealthy landowner who, upon yielding an exceptionally profitable harvest one year, determines that he will live the rest of his days in relaxation; to eat, drink and be merry. God calls the miser a "fool" and lets him know that his greed and self-indulgence will not bring him the security he seeks. Good stewards acknowledge that the money and possessions entrusted to them are to be used to further the mission of Jesus Christ. This week let us reflect on our own daily consumption habits. Do we spend money on articles that make us better ambassadors of Christ? Does our personal lifestyle bring "good news to the poor" (Luke 4:18)?

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

When Pope Pius XII died in 1958, there was the usual buzz of speculation about likely successors. Cardinal Agajanian, Patriarch of the Armenians, was highly thought of as a likely choice. This took many Catholics by surprise, since he had never celebrated the same liturgy as Pope Pius, but followed ancient Armenian customs according to the Eastern Church, which veils the Eucharistic liturgy from sight by a series of curtains, and in which the priest kneels while the people stand for Communion.

In the years that followed, the Second Vatican Council would affirm the dignity and independence of the Eastern Churches, in complete union with Rome, yet different in patterns of life and worship. We have the same faith, the same sacraments, and the same pope. Yet everywhere in the world our separate Churches are combined into families held together by the ministry of bishops. All of this serves as warning: If you ever say, "But we've always done it this way," you are on very thin ice indeed! —James Field, Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co.
