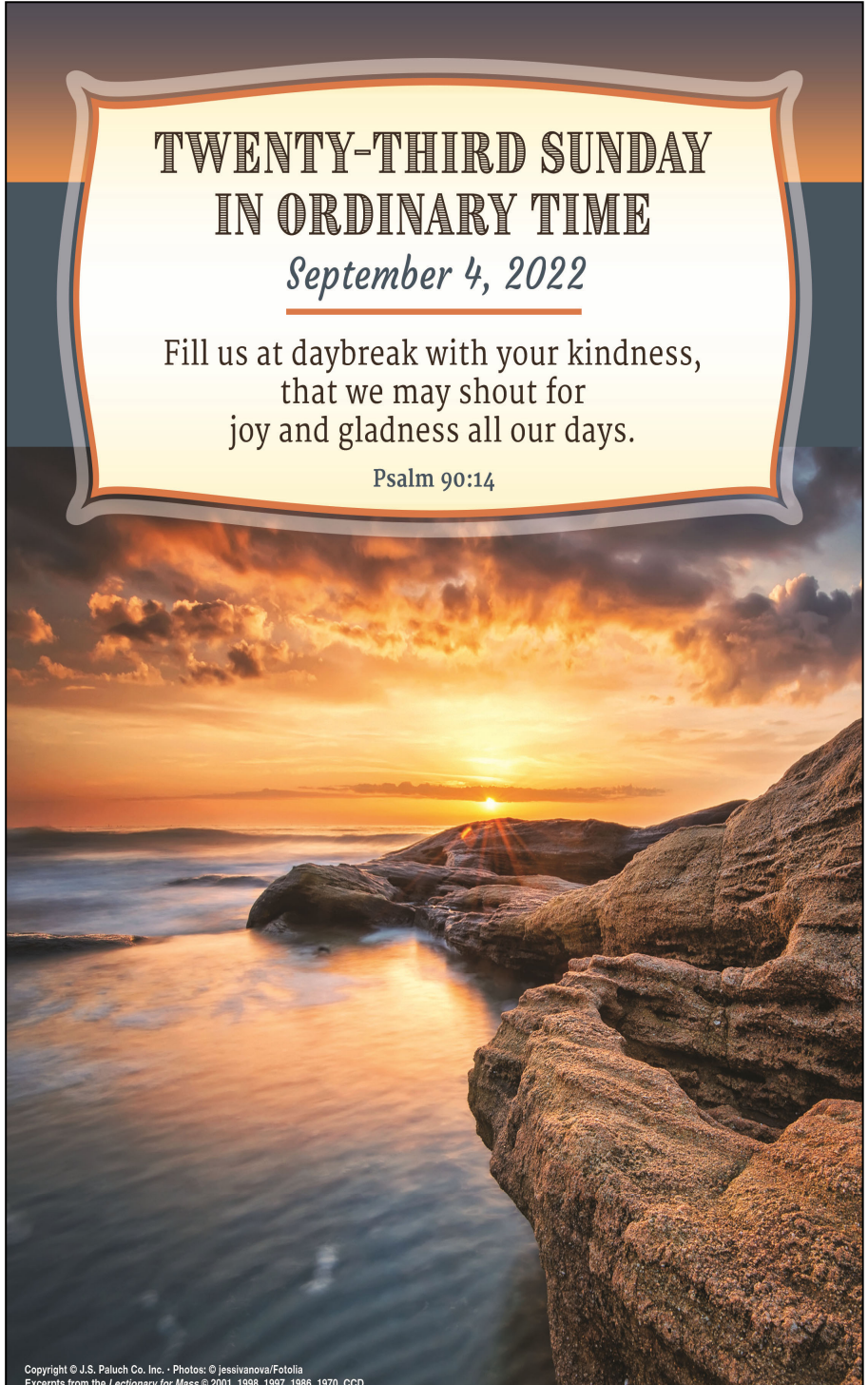

ST. REGIS STEWARDSHIP CORNER

"Who can know God's counsel, or who can conceive what the LORD intends?" In today's Gospel, Jesus counsels us on three obstacles to discipleship: relationships with our neighbor, ourselves and our stuff. None of these can get in the way of following Jesus, but all three of these relationships can assist us in becoming missionary disciples. First, Jesus tells us we must hate our neighbor to be his disciple, boy, does that sound contrary to the Gospel. We might ask ourselves—who in my life do I put ahead of our Lord? Then he shared with us how we must carry our own crosses and follow him. What cross(es) have I not embraced? Or, am I carrying someone else's cross—a cross too many? Lastly, we are to renounce all our possessions. Think time, talent and treasure, and try to give it, live it and share it!

Ninguno de estos puede interponerse en el camino de seguir a Jesús, pero estas tres relaciones pueden ayudarnos a convertirnos en discípulos misioneros. Primero, Jesús nos dice que debemos odiar a nuestro prójimo para ser su discípulo, muchacho, ¿eso suena contrario al Evangelio? Podríamos preguntarnos: ¿a quién en mi vida pongo por delante de nuestro Señor? Luego compartió con nosotros cómo debemos llevar nuestras propias cruces y seguirlo. ¿Qué cruz(es) no he abrazado? O, ¿estoy cargando la cruz de otra persona, una cruz demasiado? Por último, debemos renunciar a todas nuestras posesiones. ¡Piensa en el tiempo, el talento y el tesoro, y trata de darlo, vivirlo y compartirlo!

THE SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING OF THE SICK

The Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick, often referred to as Extreme Unction or Last Rites, is a ritual of healing appropriate not only for those in immediate danger of death but also for those suffering from physical, mental, or spiritual sickness. When a priest confers this Sacrament, the individual receives from the Holy Spirit the Graces of strengthening, peace, and courage to overcome the difficulties that go with the condition of serious illness or the frailty of old age. Also, the Sacrament formally unites the suffering of the individual with that of Christ's Passion and confers a Grace that contributes to the sanctification of the whole Church.

If a sick person who received this anointing recovers his health, he can in the case of another grave illness receive this sacrament again. If during the same illness the person's condition becomes more serious, the sacrament may be repeated. It is fitting to receive the Anointing of the Sick just prior to a serious operation. If circumstances suggest it, the Anointing of the Sick should be received following the Sacrament of Penance.

Finally, for those who are about to leave this life, the Sacrament completes the holy anointings that mark the whole Christian life and fortifies the individual for their final journey. In such cases, the priest will also often offer the Eucharist in the form of *Holy Viaticum* (food for the journey).

NEED TO RECEIVE ANOINTING OF THE SICK?

If you suffer from a chronic illness, the affect of advanced years or have an upcoming surgery and wish to receive this sacrament, Let Fr. Lopez know before the mass you attend, and he will anoint you after mass. If you would like to schedule it in advance or make appointment for a weekday, contact Esmeralda Lopez at (816) 761-1608.

EL SACRAMENTO DE LA UNCIÓN DE LOS ENFERMOS

El Sacramento de la Unción de los Enfermos, a menudo conocido como Extremaunción o la Última Consagración, es un ritual de curación apropiado no sólo para los que están en peligro inmediato de muerte, sino también para los que sufren una enfermedad física, mental o espiritual. Cuando un sacerdote confiere este Sacramento, la persona recibe del Espíritu Santo las gracias de fortalecimiento, paz y valor para superar las dificultades que conlleva la condición de enfermedad grave o la fragilidad de la vejez. Además, el Sacramento une formalmente el sufrimiento del individuo con el de la Pasión de Cristo y confiere una Gracia que contribuye a la santificación de toda la Iglesia.

Si un enfermo que ha recibido esta unción recupera la salud, puede, en caso de otra enfermedad grave, volver a recibir este sacramento. Si durante la misma enfermedad el estado de la persona se agrava, el sacramento puede repetirse. Es conveniente recibir la Unción de los Enfermos justo antes de una operación grave. Si las circunstancias lo aconsejan, la Unción de los Enfermos debe recibirse después del Sacramento de la Penitencia.

Por último, para quienes están a punto de dejar esta vida, el Sacramento completa las santas unciones que marcan toda la vida cristiana y fortalece al individuo para su viaje final. En estos casos, el sacerdote suele ofrecer también la Eucaristía en forma de Santo Viático (alimento para el viaje).

¿Necesita recibir la Unción de los Enfermos?

Si usted sufre de una enfermedad crónica, la afectación de la edad avanzada o tiene una cirugía próxima y desea recibir este sacramento, hágase saber al Padre López antes de la misa a la que asiste, y él lo ungirá después de la misa. Si desea programarlo con anticipación o hacer una cita para un día de semana, comuníquese con Esmeralda López al (816) 761-1608.
