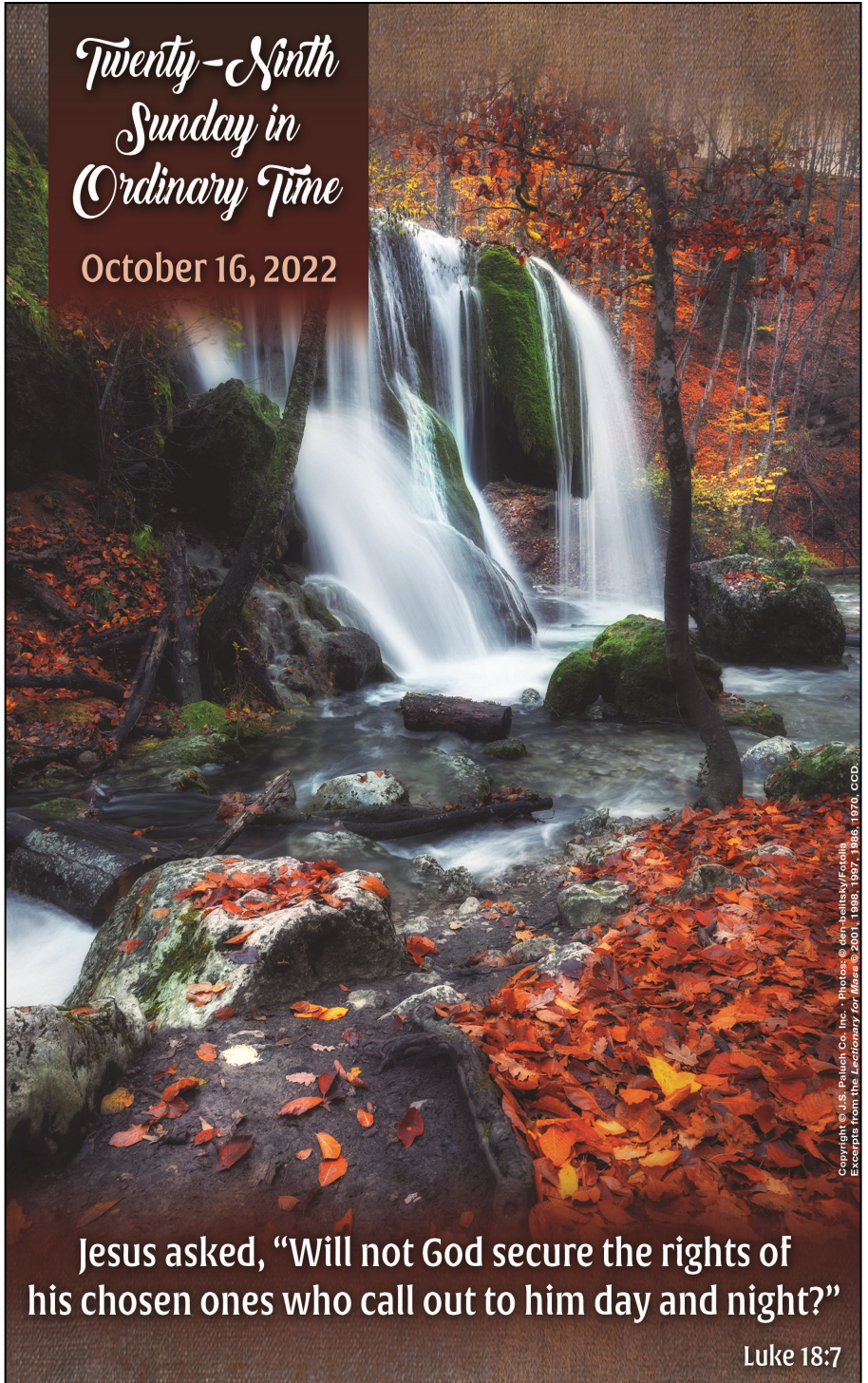

ST. REGIS STEWARDSHIP CORNER

If we want to know what Jesus’ parable is about in today’s Gospel, it seems that we don’t need to work too hard because Saint Luke tell us right at the beginning: “Jesus told his disciples a parable about their need to pray always and not to lose heart.” This parable has often been used to bring comfort to us about our prayer life. But could there be a more challenging message for those who take stewardship seriously? Widows were the poorest and most vulnerable of people in Jesus’ time. Oppressive legal and economic structures were the norm. Jesus embraced with great compassion the poor and the marginalized. Could it be that we are also encouraged to pray persistently for the poor, the weak and the vulnerable as we hear their cry for justice? And that we must not lose heart that we can effect change in their lives?

Si queremos saber de qué trata la parábola de Jesús en el Evangelio de hoy, parece que no tenemos que esforzarnos demasiado en buscar, ya que San Lucas nos dice justamente en el inicio: “Jesús dijo a sus discípulos una parábola acerca de su necesidad de orar siempre y no desalentarse.” Esta parábola a menudo ha sido usada para confortarnos en nuestra vida de oración. ¿Pero podría haber un mensaje más desafiante para aquellos que toman seriamente la corresponsabilidad? Las viudas eran las personas más pobres y vulnerables en el tiempo de Jesús. Las estructuras jurídicas y económicas opresivas eran la norma. Jesús abrazó con gran compasión al pobre y al marginado. ¿Podría ser también que nos aliente a orar persistentemente por el pobre, el marginado y el vulnerable al escuchar su grito por justicia? ¿Y nos insista en que no debemos desalentarnos para que podamos realizar cambios en sus vidas?
