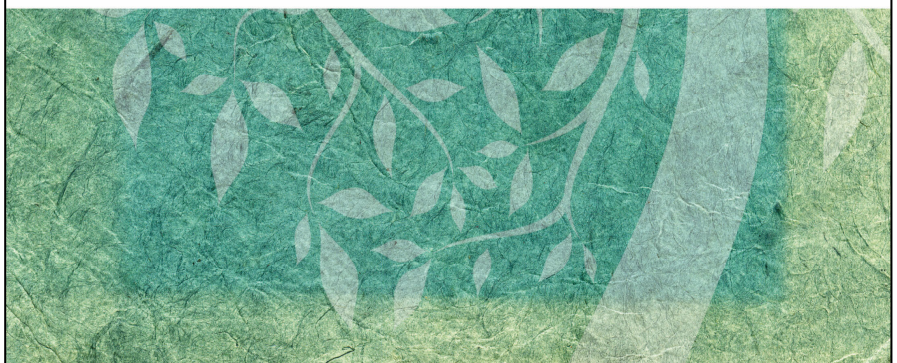

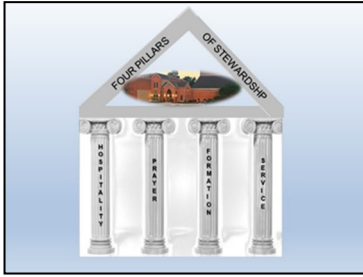

## MEMORIAL MASS

## PRIESTHOOD SUNDAY

Priesthood Sunday is a special day set aside to honor priesthood in the United States. It is a day to reflect upon and affirm the role of the priesthood in the life of the Church as a central one. The **28th of October**, the last Sunday of October, parishioners of St. Regis are encouraged to offer a prayer of thanksgiving and offer support for our pastor Fr. Priesthood Sunday was established in 2001 to honor Priesthood in the Church and recognize those who are called to this life of Service.

## ST. REGIS STEWARDSHIP CORNER

In today's Gospel Jesus teaches his disciples that whoever wishes to be great among them must be a servant, just as he came to be a servant. Today is World Mission Sunday – a reminder of our call to be good stewards of the Gospel and to support those who make evangelization their servant ministry throughout the world. Not to be a servant of the Gospel would be poor stewardship. But how do we serve the Gospel in our daily lives? How do we support others who serve those who have never heard the Gospel or who have chosen to reject the Gospel of Jesus Christ?

## FATAL FLAWS

On **Sunday, October 21 at 6:30pm** there will be a showing of the movie *Fatal Flaws*, in Mary's room. *Fatal Flaws* is a documentary about the "flaws" of legalizing Assisted Death.

## THE NEOCATECHUMENAL WAY

On Tuesday's and Thursday's beginning **October 23rd** there will be a missionary team of catechists from the Neocatechumenal Way giving a series of one hour talks to adults and youth at 7pm in Mary's Room.

The Neocatechumenal Way is a post baptismal catechumenate that began in Spain after Vatican II. Saint John Paul II, when speaking of the Neocatechumenal Way, described it as "an itinerary of Catholic formation valid for our society and our times". He also said that it "...is authentic and is consistent with the very nature of the parish, because just as each one of us Christians grows from baptism, so does the Christian community grow naturally from baptism. ... The parish can grow authentically in the experience and on the basis of the neocatechumenal experience; it would be like the renewal of the early community that grew out of the catechumenal experience." A team of missionary catechists will be speaking in our parish these coming weeks. If you find yourself in the midst of problems, questions, or just want to deepen your faith, come and listen.
