All Saints Day, **November 1st**, is a holy day of obligation. Mass will be at 6:15am, 8:30am with St. Regis School and 7pm.

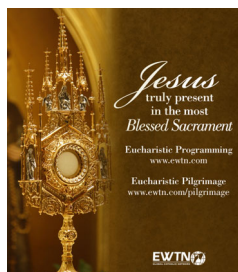
WORLD MISSION SUNDAY
